## Visitors to depots.

Depot personnel and train crews are reminded of SteamRanger's requirements allowing visitors to enter the depot. These requirements are that all visitors must be suitably dressed with appropriate footware, given a brief induction and sign the visitor's indemnity book on arrival.

## Visitors in depot during shunting and loco preparation

Depot personnel and loco crews are requested to be vigilant and to enforce the policy that visitors are not allowed within 3 metres of a running line. Any personnel not involved in shunting MUST keep well clear of ALL movements and ensure others, particularly visitors, do likewise.

Recently unauthorised persons have been entering the rail gates to take photographs. Please advise any persons entering through the rail gates that their actions are a safety issue and they are trespassing then politely request them to leave.

Loco crews are also reminded that paragraph 5.5 of WPO 11 states;

"All active locomotives and railcars during shunting or any other movement MUST have their side marker lamps illuminated to indicate to other personnel that the locomotive or railcar is active. Before any movement of the locomotive or railcar takes place the headlight in the direction of travel MUST be illuminated."
